GRADING SYSTEM:

The French system uses the 0-20 grading scale. All the grades are assigned out of 20.

The highest possible grade is 20 out of 20, the lowest possible grade is 0 out of 20, the average mark is 10 out of 20.

The average mark is required to pass

Depending on his / her grade, the student can also get the following honours:

- From 10 to 12 out of 20: « mention passable » = pass
- From 12 to 14 out of 20: « mention assez bien » = satisfactory
- From 14 to 16 out of 20: « mention bien » = good
- From 16 to 18 out of 20: « mention très bien » = excellent
- From 18 to 20 out of 20: « félicitations » = excellent with honours

Courses are organized as follow:

- First semester starts in September, ends in January. The second semester starts in January, ends in June
- The License includes 6 semesters : Numbered even (pair) (2, 4, 6) and odd (impair) (1, 3, 5)
- All our courses are taught in FRENCH ONLY. We trust university to check students' French level (B2 level required)
- Students must attend the courses, and do the exams. If they fail or do not come, they will not get the ECTS.
- Exams: A special winter session is organized for international students the last week in December. The spring session occurs in April-May, and the second session in June.
- Students have to choose a Block of units (except when it includes an internship)
(for ex, in our program: the course 55.1 is divided in 55.1 A, 55.1 B and 55.1 C.
The student cannot take only 55.1 A ! He must choose the 3 units.)
- Students can follow courses in other faculties in Montpellier (Economy, university of Paul Valery, etc...), but they must choose at least 50% courses in STAPS.
The student has to contact the other faculty and adjust himself his timetable between both faculties.
- **Students' learning agreement must contain at least 50% of theoretical courses.** Our pedagogical rule is to motivate students to choose some theoretical courses, and not doing only sport. For that reason, we decided to limit the number of sport activities.
