
There are currently no classes specifically designed for International Students. Exchange students can select courses offered in any UFR STAPS bachelor degrees.

They must select several instructional units (UE):

- ➤ Each unit is made of several subjects: all subjects have to be attended in order to complete the selected unit.
- → Exchange Students have to choose a <u>block of units</u>(except when it includes an internship). For example, in our program: the course 931.1 is divided in 931.1 A, 931.1 B. The student cannot take only 931.1 A. He must choose the 2 units.
- → The only exception to this rule is if an internship makes up part of an instructional unit, the student will be exempted from the internship and the internship report.

Exchange Students must select theoretical courses as well as practical courses so that their learning agreement includes a minimum of half theoretical classes.

Exchange Students may attend courses in other faculties of University of Montpellier, in which case at least 50% of their courses must belong to UFR STAPS program. It is their responsibility to contact these faculties and organize their own schedule.





GRADING SYSTEM

The French system uses the 0-20 grading scale. All the grades are assigned out of 20.

The highest possible grade is 20 out of 20, the lowest possible grade is 0 out of 20, the average mark is 10 out of 20.

A student may be awarded the following honours:

Each semester awards up to 30 ECTS (European Credits Transfer System).

LANGUAGES

As UFR STAPS classes (both practical and theoretical) are taught in French only, students should be able to follow university lectures in French and take the exams (written or oral) in French. This means that applicants should be at least **B2** level users of the French language, although a language test certificate is not required from exchange students.

→ For self-assessment regarding your language skills, you can use the self-assessment grid corresponding to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages

The University of Montpellier additionally offers French Language Classes (FLE: Français Langue Étrangère).

NOMINATION & APPLICATION

Requirements for an exchange semester/year at UFR STAPS:

Please note that only students from our partner universities can apply for an exchange semester/year at UFR STAPS. Before applying, you have to be nominated by your home university's international coordinator. They are no other specifics requirements necessary, except for the **B2** level in French language.

How to apply:

After your home university went through the nomination process, we will contact you and send you all relevant information needed for your exchange studies via email. We will send you a list of documents you will have to submit in order to process your application.

> Please make sure you provide a **valid email** address.

Documents to submit:

Copy of passport/ID card, medical certificate (English or French only), ID Photo + insurance documents described below.

Classes enrollment:

No prior registration is needed. International Relations Office will guide students upon arrival.



TIMELINE

- 1. Contact your University International Relations Office.
- 2. Your University inform us about your nomination.
- 3. We send you all the instructions and documents to be filled.
- 4. You filled these application papers with your pedagogical and administrative coordinator and send it to us.
- 5. Upon reception, we send you a letter of admission if you need it.
- 6. You must gather needed documents and send them to STAPS International Office before your arrival.
- 7. Upon arrival, we will guide you through your administrative and classes' enrollment.

GENERAL INFORMATIONS

Accommodation:

The CROUS international student service offers accommodation in university halls or residences.

Prices range from 180€ per month for a single room with shared bathroom and toilets facilities to 500€ per month for a 29m² studio flat.

Please note that you have to register at the International Relations Office of UFR STAPS. You should not apply directly to the CROUS.

- European Health Insurance Card (EU citizens) / Private Health Insurance (non-EU citizens)
- Liability insurance
- Repatriation insurance
